I performed an autopsy on the body of JANIS JOPLIN  
at OFFICE OF CHIEF MEDICAL EXAMINER-CORONER, HALL OF JUSTICE,  
LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA  
and from the anatomic findings and pertinent history I ascribe the death to:

ACUTE HEROIN-MORPHINE INTOXICATION

DUE TO: INJECTION OF OVERDOSE

Final Oct. 28, 1970

ANATOMIC SUMMARY

- I. Pulmonary edema and congestion.
- II. Visceral congestion.
- III. Needle marks, arms, bilateral.
- IV. Fatty metamorphosis of liver.

EXTERNAL EXAMINATION:

The unembalmed body is that of a Caucasian female, appearing the stated age of 27. A tattoo of a bracelet is present around the left wrist. A small tattoo of a flower is present just behind the lateral malleolus on the right heel. There is also a small heart tattooed over and medial to, the left breast. Numerous needle marks are present in the arms bilaterally, both in the antecubital fossa and on the left lateral anterior margin of the left arm. On sectioning, there appears to be at least two fresh hemorrhagic areas on the lateral margin of the left arm. The antecubital fossa shows, what appears to be, old needle marks and some are of relatively recent origin. An old surgical scar is present in the right lower quadrant of the abdomen. There is a slight amount of bloody material present in the mouth and on further examination, some disruption of the mucosa is noted. No evidence of major trauma or of violence is present. The hair is of moderate length and shows a varying shade of, from blond to brunette. The eyes are blue and show moderate dilatation of the pupils. The external genitalia is female. There is some irregular dependent livor with pressure changes chiefly on the left side, suggesting body rest on the left side.

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INTERNAL EXAMINATION, INCISION:

The usual Y-shaped incision is employed. There is no accumulation of blood or fluid in either abdominal or thoracic spaces. The organs appear in their usual positions.

RESPIRATORY SYSTEM:

The larynx, trachea, and bronchi show moderate congestion of mucosa. A small amount of foamy material is present in the upper portion of the trachea and continues toward the lower portion. The right lung weighs 550 grams; left 500 grams. The cut surfaces show marked congestion and edema, bilaterally, but no definite recognizable hemorrhage or consolidation. Pulmonary vessels are grossly normal.

CARDIOVASCULAR SYSTEM:

The aorta and its branches show no significant arteriosclerosis. The heart weighs 300 grams, lies within a smooth pericardial sac. The epicardial and endocardial surfaces are smooth. The coronary arteries show no significant arteriosclerosis. The valve appearances and sizes are grossly normal. The cut surfaces of myocardium show no recognizable old, recent, or fresh infarct. Venous system shows no gross abnormalities.

HEMIC AND LYMPHATIC SYSTEM:

The abdominal and mediastinal nodes are not remarkably enlarged. The spleen weighs approximately 290 grams, has a red-purple parenchyma and a smooth capsule.

DIGESTIVE SYSTEM:

The esophagus shows no gross abnormalities. The stomach contains a small amount of fluid and partially digested food particles. The small bowel and colon are grossly normal. The appendix shows no gross abnormality. The pancreas has the usual lobular yellow-tan appearance. The liver weighs 2050 grams and has a smooth capsule. The parenchyma is yellowish-brown and shows some glistening of the surface. There is no significant accentuation of lobules or increase in fibrous components. The gallbladder and biliary tree are grossly normal.

UROGENITAL SYSTEM:

The kidneys weigh: Right 180 grams; left 170 grams. The capsules strip with ease. The cortex is up to 4 or 5 mm. in thickness. The pelvis, ureters, and urinary bladder are grossly normal. The uterus contains an intra-uterine contraceptive device, of the serpentine-type. The endometrium is yellow-tan and is somewhat shaggy. The uterine, tubes, and ovaries show no gross abnormalities.

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ENDOCRINE SYSTEM:

The adrenals show no recognizable abnormality. The thyroid weighs approximately 78 grams and has the usual glistening pinkish-tan appearance. The pituitary shows no gross abnormality.

SKULL AND CENTRAL NERVOUS SYSTEM:

The scalp, calvarium, and dura are free of abnormality. The brain weighs 1450 grams. The arteries at the base show no significant arteriosclerosis. The leptomeninges are moderately congested. Multiple sections through cerebrum, cerebellum, midbrain and pons show no recognizable hemorrhage, infarct, or neoplasm. The ventricular system is normal in size.

MUSCULOSKELETAL SYSTEM:

No gross deformities of the extremities are noted. The subcutaneous tissues and skin surfaces, bilaterally, show multiple needle marks in the arms. The lower extremities show no gross abnormality. The rib cage show no recognizable fractures. The thoracic and lumbar spine appear grossly normal.

TOXICOLOGY:

Specimen of blood, liver, kidney, stomach contents, gallbladder contents and urine, are submitted for toxicological study. Routine hold and microscopic sections are also taken.

## CONTINUATION SHEET

- 1100 hrs - Arrived at decedent's residence (7047 Franklin Avenue, Apt. 105) with Dr. Noguchi, Dr. Katsuyama and William Lystrup for further investigation. Public Administrator seal broken and apartment entered by above.
- 1110 hrs - Gauze noted on decedent's bed; gauze found in waste basket in livingroom with apparent dried blood residue.
- 1120 hrs - The end of a red balloon or rubber glove was found in a waste basket in decedent's kitchen containing a white powder. A large disposable towel was found with apparent dried blood residue with below evidence.
- 1140 hrs - An apparent hype kit consisting of a teaspoon with black smudge, a small piece of cotton and dried residue; a needle and plastic syringe containing a clear liquid and a paper package containing a brownish white powder was found in the top right dresser drawer in decedent's livingroom. Also found in the drawer was a plastic bag containing possible marijuana, and a small plastic bag with 4-1/2 small white tablets "Lilly 172."
- 1200 hrs - All above evidence was impounded and brought in and decedent's residence was locked and re-sealed by the undersigned.

## CONTINUATION SHEET

Information from Sgt. Sanchez, D.H.Q. and John Cooke, Game warden. As decedent, Apt. 223 (851-2000), working under contract to defendant's group.

Decedent was 27-year-old female, and stage singer by occupation. Her group is called "Joplin Full Tilt Boogie" composed of herself and group of musicians - under "Fantality Inc." licensed to engage in the State of California.

On 10-3-70 at about 2400 hrs., Decedent was in studio at "Sunset Sound Recorder" located on Sunset. After recording some music, decedent together with another man (unknown name & address) dropped in at "Barney's Beany" at 8447 Santa Monica Blvd. and took about two or three drinks. Decedent was last seen alive by Jack Hayes, mgr. of Hyattcourt (851-2000) about 0100 hrs., 10-4-70, coming home, alone.

This evening, before 1915 hrs., Mr. Cooke (Game) saw decedent's car outside of the garage. Concerned why the car was parked outside, Cooke called up decedent between 1915-1920 hrs. 10-4-70, but no response. He then borrowed key of the manager, entered the room and found decedent lying on the floor between chair and bed, eyes closed. Cooke then called decedent's lawyer & a doctor and called police, R-17-A-35 at scene 2110 hrs. 10-4-70 and pronounced death same hour.

Decedent was abd. lying on her left side, clad to blouse and pants. No rigor mortis noted and body mortis about 4+. A small Cigarette on the lower lip of decedent noted fresh. but no fall. Multiple needle marks (fresh) noted on the left antecubital fossa and 0.50 marks on the right. The airconditioner at scene was on & no signs of struggle noted in the room. Ophthalmic consult and tablets for pain found on bed. Delirium consult and no signs of trauma or foul play.
