Investigation:

This death was reported to our office on 07/01/2017 at 13:59 hours by Officer Doughty. This death was labeled as a suicide in the field. The decedent was discovered hanging in her residence by an elastic band around her neck on 07/01/2017 at 13:30 hours by her parents. 911 was called and LAFD Engine #68 arrived onto the scene and pronounced the decedent in place on 07/01/2017 at 13:40 hours. No trauma was noted. No foul play is suspected. No suicide note was found at the scene.

I was assigned to this case for investigation on 07/01/2017 at 14:15 hours by Lt. Smith.

I arrived onto the scene and interviewed Officer Doughty on 07/01/2017 at 15:00 hours.

I examined the decedent at the scene on 07/01/2017 at 15:10 hours.

I interviewed Steve Ryan and family at the scene on 07/01/2017 at 15:45 hours.

I collected medical evidence and property before clearing the scene on 07/01/2017 at 16:00 hours.

Informant/Witness Statements:

According to Officer Doughty, the decedent had a medical history of depression and anxiety. The decedent was being treated by mental health professionals for the past two years. The decedent spoke with her mother via telephone on 06/30/2017 at 19:30 hours and stated "Now that grandpa is dead, there's no reason to live". The decedent's parents drove to the decedent's residence on 07/01/2017 after multiple unsuccessful attempts to get into contact with the decedent. The decedent's parents arrived at the decedent's residence and found the front door to be unlocked. Upon entering the residence, the decedent was found hanging from a hook attached to the door by an elastic band wrapped around her neck. 911 was called and LAFD Engine #68 arrived onto the scene. The decedent was pronounced in place on 07/01/2017 at 13:40 hours by Paramedic Conish #82431. No trauma was noted. No foul play is suspected. No suicide note was found at the scene.

According to Steve Ryan, the decedent worked as an actress and in 2015 started developing depression and anxiety. The decedent started having suicidal ideations and was treated by mental health professionals. The decedent was prescribed medications and was being treated with transcranial magnetic stimulation. The decedent was known to smoke marijuana and drink alcohol on rare occasions. The decedent mentioned to her family that she made an unsuccessful attempt at suicide by hanging herself within the past month. The decedent was never placed onto a psychiatric hold. The decedent's mental conditions were suspected to be originated from her professional career. The decedent was taken off Prozac two weeks prior to her death. The decedent dealt with insomnia and fluctuating eating habits. No suicide note was found by her family or boyfriend.

Scene Description:

The decedent was located against a door that separated the living room from her bedroom/bathroom quarters in her one bedroom apartment. The apartment was located on the second floor of a two story apartment complex. The residence was in a clean and tidy order. No signs of forced entry were noted at the residence. Prescriptions medications were collected from the kitchen area. A journal that was located in the living room stated that the decedent was dealing with depression and was taking Xanax. No suicide note was found at the scene. The decedent's cellphone was located on her bed and was unable to be accessed due to security passcode restrictions. The height of the door was 81" from the floor. A metal hook over hanged from the top of the door and an elastic band hung from the hook. The distance of the elastic band from the hook to the neck knot was 40". Height from the neck knot to the floor was 38". A plastic "Squatty Potty" was located underneath the decedent's buttocks. Marijuana and glass pipes were located throughout the residence.

Evidence:

Prescription medications were collected from the scene on 07/01/2017 at 16:00 hours.

Body Examination:

The decedent was a Caucasian female in fair condition in a fowler's position with her back against a door and her lower extremities folded underneath her buttocks in contact with the floor. No trauma was noted on the decedent. No tattoos or deformities were noted on the decedent. No petechial hemorrhaging was noted in the eyes. The decedent's tongue was protruding from her mouth and sputum was seen trailing from her mouth onto her torso. No defensive wounds were noted to the extremities. An elastic band was wrapped around her neck and the ligature was leading in a superior direction on the posterior region of her neck, behind her ears. A ring and two necklaces were removed from the body and given to the decedent's family at the scene. Rigor mortis was rated at four throughout the body. Lividity was noted in the inferior regions of the torso and extremities. Ambient temperature was 80.5 degrees at 15:22 hours. Liver temperature was 79.2 degrees at 15:26 hours.


