7 Dec 1910 - I saw it 100 yard  
off shore ~~near~~ 13 rd buoy &  
left bank. Small catch on left  
arm, 3 o'clock broach on dress  
in front, 1 catheye frog under dress  
Re dress & Re show - very  
On right leg 2 ticks with round &  
an elong R Knob - Name Roger &  
Bonne on left side: Is shot down  
slope of hair about  $1\frac{1}{2}$  in from left  
eye. Mouth - entered mouth on L side  
~~upper~~ ~~posterior~~. Absent at center  
of cheek & above about with 1 just  
below left jaw bone and valle  
along concave left side coning  
into neck. enter bottom about 2 in  
below inner side of side r.  
Great round, about 1 in below  
it slopes other way than first  
the bone

Another round & I had left  
my breaking into joint. Once he  
shot in left hand going to chest  
which below scapula 1 shot at  
left hand there being several  
broken ribs. 6 shots hitting  
three " back. 10 gun left scapula  
5 bullet wounds about middle of left  
leg. Wounds of eat places on left leg  
other side seems cut from gun & cut  
in left ankle on top of left foot  
approximately from nose. Great damage  
seen, except 4 centers of right  
leg broken, seen opposite from  
below ~~other~~ 6 inches yes  
length about  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch on  
other 4 centers of right leg the  
opposite effect of burns, each one  
in length and width about one  
egg at the extending on account  
about few extending 6 in on inner  
side of right leg flesh would cover  
end of right arm.

Snashot mind entering  
fleshy portion left thigh  
8 labbet wound striking  
almost in parallel line  
left side 3 parallelly  
striking right side  
back from bone of neck  
to angular right scapula  
to middle back bone  
one striking midway back  
breaking both bone
