Response to Request for Information February, 2011

The St. Louis County Medical Examiner's office has released their report on the sudden death of Adrienne Martin at the home of August Busch IV on December 19, 2010. The cause of death is listed as "Oxycodone intoxication", and the manner of death is listed as "Accident." The Medical Examiner's toxicology report shows levels of cocaine and oxycodone in Ms. Martin's system. Any questions about the Medical Examiner's report should be addressed to the St. Louis County Medical Examiner.

In response to multiple requests under the Missouri public records statutes we are able to make the attached documents available to those who requested them. The materials include the Frontenac Police Department Sudden Death report of this incident, with supplemental reports. No additional documents are available for release at this time, or for the indefinite future. This Department will continue to investigate any suspected illegal conduct, including the presence of any illegal drugs in Ms. Martin's system or surroundings, for as long as necessary.

Throughout this investigation our Department has maintained close coordination with the office of the St. Louis County Prosecuting Attorney, Mr. Robert McCulloch, and we appreciate his cooperation and assistance. The decision whether to file or pursue any charges arising out of this incident, as in any other incident, rests exclusively with the Prosecuting Attorney. We have great respect for Mr. McCulloch and have confidence in his judgment.

Narrative Report of Investigation

At 1400 hours I was contacted by Officer SCRONCE DSN-240, of the Frontenac Police Department as he requested that I responded to 2832 South Lindbergh Blvd, for the possible overdose related death of a Ms. ADRIENNE N. MATRIN, white female age of 27 years. The deceased mother had been made aware of the deceased death by the Frontenac Police.

I arrived on the scene which was located in a residential neighborhood. On the scene I was met by several officers of the Frontenac Police Department. I was led to the deceased who was located in the northeast bedroom on the first floor. There I observed the deceased lying supine on the bed on top of the covers. Her head was resting on several pillows.

The deceased was clothed in one black sock on her left foot, pants, t-shirt and a jacket. In the right jacket pocket was a straw which was covered in a white residue.

The deceased was warm to the touch. Rigor mortis was absent from the body. Livor mortis was lightly observed on the left side of her face.

No injuries were observed on the deceased.

At this facility at 1600 hours the deceased liver temperature was measured at 96* F. The residence were she was discovered at was approximately 70* F.

The deceased was a guest in the residence and was with Mr. AUGUTST BUSH IV, and he reported that they were drinking most of the evening and at approximately 0330 hours they both fell asleep on the bed.

He woke up at 1145 hours and she was still in the bed and appeared to be asleep. He went to the kitchen and made a breakfast shake, then he made her one and went back into the room at approximately 1230 hours and at this time he found her unresponsive in bed. He had his assistance call 9-1-1.

It was reported that the deceased had a history of depression.

External Examination: The body is that of a well developed well nourished Caucasian woman whose appearance is consistent with the stated age. The body is 69 inches long and weighs 118 pounds. The body is well preserved. Rigor mortis is well developed. Livor mortis is posterior in distribution and blanches with pressure. The contours of the chest, back and abdomen are unremarkable. The neck is unremarkable. The extremities are normally formed. The scalp hair is brown and worn long. The skin and soft tissues of the orbits are unremarkable. The conjunctivae and sclerae are unremarkable. The irides are hazel-gray. The external aspect of the nose shows no significant abnormalities. There is some slight drying of the skin at the upper philtrum and adjacent nasal septum; however, no antemortem injuries are identified. There is a round chronic perforation of the distal nasal septum that is approximately 6 mm in diameter. The edges of the defect are lined by soft gray-white mucosa that is somewhat friable. The lips, cheeks, gums, dentition and oral cavity are unremarkable. No lesions are seen on the external or cut surfaces of the tongue. The ears are pierced. The breasts are prominent due to the presence of implants. The genitalia is unremarkable. The pubic hair, for the most part, has been shaved. Some residual pubic hair is present in the superior midline. No lymphadenopathy is identified. There is a postmortem temperature determination puncture in the right upper abdomen.

Injures: No acute injuries are identified.

Fractures: No fractures are identified.

Body Cavities: The body is opened with usual Y-shaped thoracoabdominal and intermastoidal incisions. The soft tissues of the chest and abdomen are unremarkable. The pleural, pericardial and peritoneal cavities are unremarkable. The diaphragm is unremarkable. The retroperitoneum is unremarkable.

Neck: The soft tissues of the neck are free of hemorrhage. The hyoid bone and larynx are intact and moderately pliable. The larynx, trachea and mainstem bronchi are patent. The thyroid is unremarkable.

Mediastinum: The thymus is unremarkable. The mediastinum is in the midline. The mediastinum is unremarkable.

Heart: The heart weighs 230 gms. The vascular connections of the heart are unremarkable. The endocardium and epicardium are smooth, glistening and nearly transparent. The myocardium is reddish-brown throughout. The atria and ventricles are unremarkable. The right ventricle is 3 mm thick. The left ventricle is 1 mm thick. The cardiac valves are unremarkable. The coronary ostia arise in the usual positions and are free of obstruction. The epicardial coronary arteries pursue the typical courses and are free of obstruction.

Vasculature System: The aorta is unremarkable. The systemic arteries and veins, in general, are unremarkable.

Lungs: The lungs together weigh 910 gms. The pleural surfaces are smooth and glistening. The lung parenchyma is red-purple. Cut sections through the lungs demonstrate acute congestion and edema. The bronchi and pulmonary vasculature are otherwise unremarkable.

Liver: The liver weighs 1620 gms. The capsular surfaces are smooth and glistening. The hepatic parenchyma is uniformly brown throughout. No lesions are seen on the external or cut surfaces of the liver.

Biliary Tract: The gallbladder is unremarkable.

Pancreas: The pancreas is unremarkable.

Gastrointestinal Tract: The esophagus is unremarkable. The stomach is unremarkable. The stomach contains approximately 50 ml of opaque brown well digested material. The large and small intestines are unremarkable. The colon is diffusely filled with well formed fecal material.

Spleen: The spleen weighs 270 gms. The capsule is smooth, glistening and intact. No lesions are seen on the external or cut surfaces of the red-purple splenic parenchyma.

Lymphatic System: No lymphadenopathy is identified.

Adrenal Glands: The adrenal glands are unremarkable.

Kidneys: The kidneys together weigh 380 gms. The renal capsules strip easily from the underlying smooth red-brown renal cortical surfaces. Cut sections show good corticomedullary differentiation. No lesions are seen on the cut surfaces. The renal cortices are 8mm thick. The renal medullae are unremarkable. The urinary collecting system is unremarkable.

Bladder: The bladder contains approximately 25 ml of clear yellow urine. The bladder is unremarkable.

Female Genital System: The ovaries, fallopian tubes and uterus show no significant pathologic alterations. The endometrium appears to be menstrual. No evidence of pregnancy is seen.

Cranial Cavity: The external and reflected surfaces of the scalp are unremarkable. The calvarium and base of the skull are unremarkable. The dura and leptomeninges are unremarkable. No evidence of intracranial hemorrhage is seen. The brain weighs 1410 gms. The cerebral vasculature is unremarkable. No abnormalities are seen on the external or cut surfaces of the cerebrum, cerebellum or brainstem.

Spinal Cord: The cervical spinal cord as viewed from the cranial cavity is unremarkable. The cervical spine is stable to manipulation.

On December 28, 2010, Dr. Kevin Martin called Dr. Mary Case in order to offer information about Adrienne Martin's medical history that he believed may be useful in determining the cause of his ex-wife's sudden death. He was particularly concerned about the possibility that Long QT Syndrome may have caused her death. I spoke with Dr. Martin at the request of Dr. Case. Dr. Martin sent an email this same date that included a list of the three medical facilities known to have treated Adrienne Martin, along with a summary of her medical history.

Regarding his concerns about possible Long QT Syndrome, Dr. Martin stated that while he and Adrienne were married (he could not recall the month/year), they were in his office after hours one day when she noticed an EKG machine. She asked him to run an EKG on her "to see what it was like." Dr. Martin went on to say that the computer noted a possible QT interval that was longer than normal. He checked the EKG and came to the same conclusion. He encouraged Adrienne to see a cardiologist, but she never followed up.

By email, this same date, I asked Dr. Martin what had become of that EKG and accompanying computer record. He replied that he wasn't sure and that Adrienne had taken it home with her because she wasn't a patient of his, so he had no chart on her.

On 01/13/2011, requests for medical records, specifically, any EKG or related reports, were requested from Audrain Medical Center, Boone Hospital Center and Barnes-Jewish Hospital St. Peters, the three health facilities named by Dr. Martin. Replies were received from all three facilities this same date and there were no EKG records.

I spoke with Christine Trampler, mother of Adrienne Martin, on 01/12/2011, regarding any other medical records that might include an EKG. She stated that Adrienne had no heart symptoms and had never had an EKG, as far as she knows. Ms. Trampler added that there is no family history of Long QT Syndrome. She commented that Adrienne had been taking Lexapro for about three months, but stopped when she began having "bizarre side effects." She was taking Bactrim for a skin infection shortly before she died, but she had finished the medication.

Thanks for talking to me today!

I know Adrienne had cosmetic surgery on her ears as a child in Springfield, MO I think at Cox....but I'm not sure. It could have been St. Johns. Aside from that she hadn't had much other than normal childhood illnesses except for ITP which she has had no problem with since.

She had our son at Audrain Medical Center in Mexico, MO in 2002. I don't believe they did an ECG

She had breast augmentation in 2003 at Boone Hospital in Columbia, MO

She had a peri-tonsillar abscess drained at Barnes St. Peters about 1 1/2 years ago

A few months ago she had a very bad sore throat, but wouldn't go see anyone about it. About a month or so later she called me and said her feet were so swollen she could not put her shoes on. I told her about poststreptococccal GN and begged her to see a Doc. She said she would if it didn't go away...she never did because the swelling was gone the next day. After that she developed chronic diarrea that she never sought treatment for and I believe it had not resolved at the time of her death. The last several weeks before she died she was very fatigued, but couldn't sleep. Every time I talked to her she sounded like she was wore out. She was very busy I know, changing apartments, jobs and getting ready for Christmas. The new job was very demanding and she was a perfectionist so I'm certain she was living on very little sleep. One of the last things she ever said to me on the phone was "I haven't slept for 3 days now, I am wore OUT?"

On the above date and time I received a call for an unresponsive person at 2832 S. Lindbergh Blvd. Sgt. Timothy Barnett, 232 and PO Michael Barron, 221 also responded.

Upon arrival I was met by the resident, August A. Busch IV. Busch was standing in the patio doorway motioning for me to follow him. Busch stated, "She was in the bedroom and she was not breathing". I followed Busch to the master bedroom located on the west side of the main floor.

On the bed I observed a white female, identified as Adrienne Martin, laying on her back. Martin lay motionless and appeared lifeless. Her face and hands appeared pale and her lips were blue. I checked her right wrist for a pulse and her skin was cool to the touch. She was laying on her back with her left arm underneath her body. Her head was tilted to the left side just off of the pillow. She was on top of the bedding with her head at the headboard and her feet at the footboard. Martin was clothed, wearing a black zip up sweat shirt jacket, blue undershirt, gray spandex pants and one black sock on her left foot. I did not notice any immediate signs of trauma. I checked her vital signs and detected no signs of life.

I escorted Busch to the living room while P.O. Barron stayed with Martin.

Frontenac paramedics Bill Wolf and James Brooks arrived and also checked Martin's vital signs. Wolf pronounced Martin deceased at 1326 hours. I seized the EKG printout as evidence and later

properly marked, packaged, and transferred custody of the printout to Detective James Ford, 237.

The master bedroom was cluttered with various types of electrical equipment such as power cords, adapters, cell phones and flat screen video monitors. There were also numerous half-full and nearly full bottles of Gatorade sitting on the nightstand located on the right side of the bed. Also on the nightstand I observed two plastic cups with what appeared to be melted chocolate shakes and a glass of red wine.

Although the room was cluttered and in disarray I did not see any signs of a struggle.

Busch stated that he and Martin had a relationship and she often spent the night. He added he had awakened at approximately three a.m. next to Martin and saw that she was awake but "kind of groggy". He stated he went back to sleep and did not wake up until around 1:00 p.m. He said he got out of bed, went to the kitchen, and made two protein shakes, one for each of them. He returned to the bedroom with the shakes and tried to wake her up. When he was unable to wake her he ran back to the kitchen and summoned his domestic employee, Michael Jung. Busch added they both went back to the room and tried to revive Martin but were unsuccessful. Busch stated Jung then dialed 9-1-1.

I contacted Jung, who stated he is a domestic employee of August A. Busch IV. He stated he arrived at the residence around 12:30 p.m. and started his domestic duties. He stated that at approximately 1:00 p.m. Busch came out of his bedroom to the kitchen where he made a protein shake. He said he then went out to the rear patio and, after a few minutes, Busch came out and told him that he could not wake up Adrienne. They both went to the bedroom to try to wake her up. Jung stated that neither him nor Busch moved Martin very much or repositioned her body.

Busch stated that, to his knowledge, Martin was not on any prescriptions or using any illegal drugs. He said she did not complain of an illness or appear to be sick in the previous couple of days. He added that he was unaware if she was currently being treated by a physician for any medical reasons and was unable to provide any information regarding Martin's medical history.

Detective Ford and Detective Mathew Brune, 236, responded and processed the scene. Det. Ford later further interviewed Busch in the presence of his attorney, Arthur Margulis, regarding the incident, the details of which will be supplemented by Ford.

I contacted the St. Louis County Medical Examiner's office and advised them of the circumstances. Forensic Investigator Wendell Payne responded and took possession of Martin's body per M.E. report # 8048.

In reference to the original report, the following information is supplemented.

On 12/19/2010, I responded to 2832 S. Lindbergh for a report of a Sudden Death. I arrived and met with Sgt. Tim Barnett, 232, Cpl. Rob Scronce, 240, and Officer Mike Barron, 221. Also inside the residence was homeowner August A. Busch IV, his attorney Art Margulis, and Busch's employee Mike Jung.

Cpl. Scronce directed me to the master bedroom, on the main floor on the west end of residence. I observed a white female, Adrienne Martin, lying on the left side of the bed. Martin was fully clothed and lying on top of a tan electric blanket which was unplugged. Underneath the blanket were two light green bed sheets. Near the head of Martin were three pillows, one brown and two light green.

Also lying on top of the bed, to the right of Martin, were numerous items: a laptop computer, a pair of scissors, a flashlight, an electronics magazine, a clear plastic box containing a FLPR lpod remote and a white plastic case. Attached to the footboard bed posts were two flat screen televisions.

The entire room appeared to be in disarray. Items were lying throughout the room in no identifiable pattern. The items scattered in the room were: electronic devices, powercords, televisions, remote controls, gatorade bottles, two cups of brown liquid (described as protein shakes), weapons, ammunition, radios, speakers, shoes, a watch, tools, flashlights, and a blanket. Photographs were taken of the entire room and the contents. Photographs were also taken of the master bathroom which was in equal disarray.

Inside the master bathroom, which is attached to, and directly North of the bedroom are two sinks and countertops. One on the East and one on the West side of the bathroom. Each counter top was crowded with bathroom products: toothpaste, mouthwash, soap, deodorant, cologne, ect. However, these counter tops were cluttered with electronic devices, plugs, cords, walkie-talkies, phones, flashlights, remote controls and radios. Also in the bathroom was a large bathtub, and two televisions. There was approximately 1 inch of water in the bottom of the bathtub. Next to the bathtub was a small toilet room. Inside the toilet room was a toilet, a loaded shot gun behind the door and a Glock pistol loaded with an extended magazine hanging on a hook next to the toilet

paper roll. Two closets were attached to the bathroom. One closet contained Busch's clothing and shoes. The other closet had a radio playing inside. After gaining entry to the closet it contained an IPOD that was playing, towels, washcloths, ect.

Sitting on top of a wooden chest near a large flat screen television were three prescription pill bottles, each with the name, Martin, Adrienne. One bottle was prescribed by Dr. K. Martin, dated 11/27/2010 and distributed by Walgreens Pharmacy, for Sulfameth/Trimethoprim 800/160 Tabs, with a quantity of 20. This bottle contained zero pills, however the inside of the bottle was covered with a white powder residue. A second bottle was prescribed by Dr. Blake Anderson, unclear date, and distributed by Crider Health Center Pharmacy, for Lexapro with a quantity of 30. This bottle contained zero pills, however the inside of the bottle was covered with a white powder residue. A third bottle was prescribed by Dr. L. Dupis NP/ Dr. B. Anderson, dated 11/04/2010, and distributed by Schnucks Pharmacy, for Trazodone 100mg, with a quantity of 30. This bottle contained five white pills labeled Pliva 434, a half pill labeled 434 A, and three pieces of an unknown white pill. These bottles were photographed, seized, packaged and placed into evidence. The bottles were later conveyed to the St. Louis County Crime Lab for analysis on the white powder and pills.

When the Medical Examiner's Office Forensic Investigator Wendell Payne began inspecting Martin, they rolled her further onto her left side to inspect her back area. Observed on the green sheet Martin was lying on were six dried blood spots. Each dried spot appeared to have been wiped off. Both green sheet were seized, packaged and placed into evidence. Also lying near Martin, was one white sock. This sock was seized, packaged, and placed into evidence. The tan electric blanket was seized, packaged, and placed into evidence. Also observed on Martin's left wrist was a silver and diamond Brietling watch. The watch was stopped with the time showing 5:35:08. The watch was photographed but remained with Martin.

While inspecting other areas of the bed, we lifted the top mattress to look between the mattress and box spring. Underneath Martin, between the mattress and box spring was a white plastic straw approximately 2.75 inches in length. On the inside of the straw was a white powdery substance. The straw was photographed, seized, packaged and placed into evidence. It was later conveyed to the St. Louis County Crime Lab for analysis on the white powdery substance.

The photographs of the scene were transferred to a Frontenac Detective Bureau computer, burned

In reference to the original report, the following report is supplemented.

On 12/19/2010, while at 2832 S. Lindbergh, I approached the homeowner, August Busch IV, and his attorney Art Margulis, and requested that Busch speak with me. Margulis advised me he would allow Busch to make a statement and answer limited questions.

I presented Busch with a Frontenac Police Advisement of Rights Form. I advised Busch of his rights to which he stated he understood. He then signed the form, as did Margulis and myself. The Advisement of Rights form was seized, packaged, and later placed into evidence.

I asked Busch how he knew Adrienne Martin and for how long. He stated that they had been dating on and off for approximately one and one half years, and that she often stayed at his house and the two shared a bed.

However, Busch advised me that Adrienne had left the residence on Saturday, December 18th, in the afternoon for a couple hours. Upon her return she did not again leave the residence.

Busch stated he and Adrienne ate dinner, steak, in the evening, but Adrienne did not eat very much. Busch advised me that Adrienne had not felt well recently and "looked bad," that evening.

Busch stated he was tired and went to bed around 6:00 pm on December 18th. Adrienne stayed up and was out in the TV area, on the couch near the kitchen. Busch stated he was not sleeping well and was up and down for several hours. Busch said that he asked Adrienne to come to bed numerous times but she refused and stayed up. Shortly after 2:00 am Busch convinced Adrienne to get into bed. Busch also got into bed and went to sleep.

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apartment. O'Neil advised that the apartment looked exactly as it had on 12/20/2010. Before leaving O'Neil noticed that 2 windows were unlocked. O'Neil stated that she locked the windows before securing the residence. O'Neil advised that she cannot release any of the property located inside the residence without a Power Of Attorney. I asked O'Neil if she would grant me permission to search the apartment, and O'Neil advised that would be "no problem."

necessary. K Martin stated that if Adrienne was taking Trazadone, it would have been extremely dangerous because of Adrienne's prolonged QT. K Martin advised that he was only made aware of Adrienne's use of Trazadone after her death, by August Busch IV.

On 01/04/2011, at approximately 11:18AM, I advised K Martin of his constitutional rights per the miranda decision, at which time K Martin advised that he understood his rights, and agreed to answer questions, and make statements (see attached copy of Advisement of Rights Form). K Martin was then asked if he prescribed any drugs to either August Busch IV or Adrienne, to which he responded that approximately 1 month prior he prescribed Bactrum to August and Adrienne as Adrienne had an infection on her back, and August had one on his foot. K Martin advised that both infections went away. K Martin advised that Adrienne asked him if he would write her a prescription for the generic form of Lexapro so she could try it, and he complied. K Martin stated that after trying it briefly, Adrienne told him she did not like it and switched back to Lexapro. K Martin advised that he prescribed Adrienne different medicines throughout their marriage, but never any controlled substances. K Martin further stated that he also has never prescribed controlled substances to August Busch IV. K Martin advised that August Busch IV asked him to prescribe a sleeping pill once, but K Martin told him that he could not do so because he was not August's doctor. K Martin advised that August Busch IV told him that he understood, and advised K Martin that he was a good guy. K Martin was asked if he ever witnessed or knew of Adrienne using any illegal drugs, and K Martin advised that he did not. K Martin stated he would be shocked if it was determined that Adrienne used illegal drugs.

K Martin gave permission to look through his cellular phone, however I did not find anything pertaining to this case, as K Martin stated he frequently deletes voice mail and text messages shortly after he gets them.

K Martin was asked about his relationship with August Busch IV, and K Martin advised that they were very friendly, almost like brothers. K Martin advised that he was over at August Busch's house the previous evening so that August could visit his son K Martin stated that August Busch IV told him that he thinks God is punishing him for what happened to the girl in Arizona. K Martin advised that he is worried as August appears to be somewhat depressed. K Martin advised that he does not think August's depression is as serious as August's family seems to think. K Martin stated that he plans on taking to visit August Busch IV in the future.

The Kevin Martin interview was recorded, then transferred to a compact disc, the disc was properly marked, packaged, and placed into evidence. The Advisement of Rights Form signed by Martin was also properly marked, packaged, and placed into evidence.

In reference to the original report, the following information is supplemented.

On 12/20/2010, at approximately 14:30, Detective Matt Brune, 236, and I responded to the St. Louis County Medical Examiners Office for the Post Mortem Examination of Adrienne N. Martin.

Upon arrival we met with St. Louis County Medical Examiner, Dr. Michael Graham. He advised us that he would be performing the examination.

As Dr. Graham examined the body of Martin he found no signs of trauma. While looking at her face area (eyes, mouth, nose) Dr. Graham identified a hole in the septum of her nose. Dr. Graham requested I photograph the nose, in particular, the hole. Dr. Graham held back the nostrils allowing light into the area. I took numerous photographs of the nose. Including one photograph where Dr. Graham inserted a surgical tool into one nostril, through the hole in the septum, then through the other nostril.

When asked why Adrienne Martin would have a hole in her septum, Dr. Graham stated the cause could come from Martin snorting a large amount of narcotics over a long period of time.

Dr. Graham examined the rest of the body to include the internal organs. He also drew blood and urine samples from the body for toxicology tests.

Upon conclusion of the examination Dr. Graham stated he did not find an apparent cause of death and did not estimate a time of death. He stated final results would have to wait until toxicology results are finalized and the pathologist has finished his examination.

Photographs taken during the examination were downloaded onto the Frontenac Detective Bureau computer, then burned to a disc which was packaged and placed into evidence.
