**MASS SHOOTING INCIDENT - VICTIM 14 OF 14:**

On Wednesday, December 2, 2015, at 1059 hours, a shooting incident was reported to the San Bernardino Police Department (SBPD) from the Inland Regional Center (IRC) in San Bernardino.

Two suspects, dressed in dark clothing, wearing ski masks, entered the south building and began indiscriminately shooting with semi-automatic rifles at the attendees of a Christmas party hosted for employees of the San Bernardino County Department of Public Health. The suspects left the scene prior to law enforcement arrival.

Law enforcement entered the building. Emergency medical services personnel removed multiple injured people to a triage point that was established directly across the street from the scene.

Two gunshot victims, a male and a female, designated as Victims #1 and #2, respectively, were pronounced dead at the triage point. Paramedics from the San Bernardino City Fire Department entered the IRC conference room and pronounced 12 victims dead at the scene.

Three victims, a female and two males, designated from south to north as Victims #3, #4 and #5, were pronounced dead outside the IRC conference room, on the east side of the building.

Nine victims, designated from east to west as Victims #6 through #14, were pronounced dead within the IRC conference room.

All 14 victims died as a result of multiple gunshot wounds.

The incident is under joint investigation by the San Bernardino Police Department and the Federal Bureau of Investigation

### NOTIFICATION TO THE CORONER DIVISION:

On Wednesday, December 2, 2015, at 1208 hours, the San Bernardino County Coroner's Office received a report of multiple fatalities resulting from a shooting at the Inland Regional Center (IRC), located at 1425 S. Waterman Ave., in San Bernardino.

Coroner chain of command personnel, including the division commander, Captain Kevin Lacy, responded to the Incident Command Post (ICP) established just north of the incident location, and began coordinating with the investigating agencies that included the San Bernardino Police Department (SBPD), which would have primary investigative responsibility, the San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department (SBCSD), the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, Department of Homeland Security, and other supporting agencies.

### PRELIMINARY LAW ENFORCEMENT INFORMATION:

According to Capt. Lacy, the preliminary incident assessment was as follows:

At 1059 hours, a shooting incident was reported to the SBPD from the IRC, where a Christmas party was being hosted for employees of the San Bernardino County Department of Public Health. Witnesses reported that at least two suspects, dressed in dark clothing, and wearing ski masks, entered the south building and began indiscriminately shooting with semi-automatic rifles. Following the shooting, the suspects fled in a black sport utility vehicle.

Law enforcement entered the building and extracted survivors. Emergency medical services personnel assisted multiple injured persons to a triage point that was established directly across the street from the scene.

### VICTIM INFORMATION:

It was subsequently learned that multiple attendees were injured; 21 were transported to local hospitals and 14 victims were pronounced dead at the scene.

Two gunshot victims, a male and a female, designated as Victims #1 and #2, respectively, were pronounced dead at the triage point. Paramedics from the San Bernardino City Fire Department pronounced three victims dead outside the south building conference room and pronounced nine victims dead inside the conference room.

Three victims, a female and two males, designated from south to north as Victims #3, #4 and #5, were pronounced dead outside the conference room, on the east side of the building. Nine victims, designated from east to west as Victims #6 through #14, were pronounced dead within the IRC conference room.

Additional briefings were conducted at the Coroner Division to activate a Family Assistance Center and a scene response plan was prepared.

### SCENE DESCRIPTION: INSIDE CONFERENCE ROOM

I was assigned to respond with Deputy Coroner Investigator L. Perriello and Deputy Coroner Investigator M. Leyva to the scene in order to coordinate the Coroner response for the investigation and recovery of remains.

On 12/03/2015 at 0052 hours, we responded from the Central Coroner Division in San Bernardino and arrived at 0111 hours. There we met with SBPD Det. William Flesher, who was assigned to act as our primary liaison.

The inside ambient temperature at the scene upon our arrival was estimated to be approximately 60 degrees Fahrenheit.

The Inland Regional Center (1365 S. Waterman Ave.) was located on the east side of Waterman Ave., surrounded by Park Center Circle. The primary complex consisted of three large buildings on approximately five acres. The buildings were surrounded by paved parking lots encircling the complex. The two northern buildings were multi-story structures (from north to south, 1365 and 1395 S. Waterman Ave, respectively). The south building (1425 S. Waterman Ave.), which contained multi-purpose rooms, consisted of two floors. There were glass entrance doors to the north and three doors located on the east side, accessing the east parking lot.

The glass doors on the east side of the building were designated as follows:

1. South door
2. Center door (Glass door was shattered)
3. North door

The south building contained a large conference room. The large conference room was divided into two separate rooms by an expandable wall partition. The south door entered the southern room. The center and north doors entered the north room where the shooting occurred. The north room was about 85x40 feet in size. The floor was covered with wall to wall carpet squares. There appeared to be no padding beneath the carpet squares. The carpet was saturated with water throughout the room. A large, half circle table was located near the north wall. There were eight groups of tables running north/south. Each group had two, six foot tables in tandem. All the tables were to the north of the center door. The tables were decorated with various Christmas decorations. There was an 18 foot buffet table along the south wall. The ceiling tiles above the buffet area had fallen to the floor. There was a Christmas tree near the southwest corner of the room.

The room was in disarray. The chairs, food, property and decorations were strewn about the room. There were several dozen cartridge casings around the room. There were multiple bullet holes in the ceiling, walls, furniture and floor.

Nine decedents inside the conference room were designated as Victims #6-14.

Victim #6 (701509092) was located about 6'8" southwest of the north door, between the easternmost groups of tables.

Victim #7 (701509093) was located about 14 feet southwest of the north door, east of the southernmost tables.

Victim #8 (701509094) was located about 30 feet southwest of the north door, between two tables.

Victim #9 (701509095) was located about 35 feet southwest of the north door, east of the southernmost tables.

Victim #10 (701509096) was located about 2 feet west of Victim #8.

Victim #11 (701509097) was located about 1 foot southwest of Victim #10.

Victims #12-14 (701509098-701509100) were located about 60 feet southwest of the north door, near the Christmas tree. Victim #13 was about 1 foot to the south of Victim #12. Victim #14 was about 1 foot southeast of Victim #13.

SBCSD Scientific Investigations Division personnel took photographs and measurements inside the conference room. Precise measurements can be obtained if needed.

We received information that there may have been explosives in the building with one or more detonated. It was later determined there were no explosives detonated inside the building.

### BODY EXAMINATIONS:

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Deputy Coroner Investigator L. Perriello, Deputy Coroner Investigator M. Leyva, and I conducted the body examinations together.

**EXAMINATION OF THE BODY OF VICTIM #14 (MICHAEL WETZEL):**

I began my examination of the body at 0745 hours. The body was a White male. The body was right lateral. The head was oriented to the east and the feet to the west. The right arm was under the torso with the right hand resting on the left forearm. The left arm was bent at the elbow with the hand resting on the carpet near the torso.

**IDENTIFICATION:**

On Scene:

I located a San Bernardino County picture identification card (A7347) on the body with the name Michael Wetzel.

Confirmation:

On 12/3/15 at 1044 hours, the decedent was confirmed to be Michael Wetzel DOB: 04/29/78 by fingerprints submitted to CAL-ID.

**BODY TRANSPORTED TO CORONER MORGUE FACILITY:**

Coroner Morgue personnel, Autopsy Assistants Mark Schrader and Karina Gomez, transported the body from the scene at 0821 hours to the Coroner Morgue Facility in San Bernardino, arriving at 0828 hours.

**NOTIFICATION OF DEATH TO NEXT OF KIN:**

On 12/03/2015 at 1450 hours, Deputy Coroner Investigator D. McCarthy made the notification of the death.

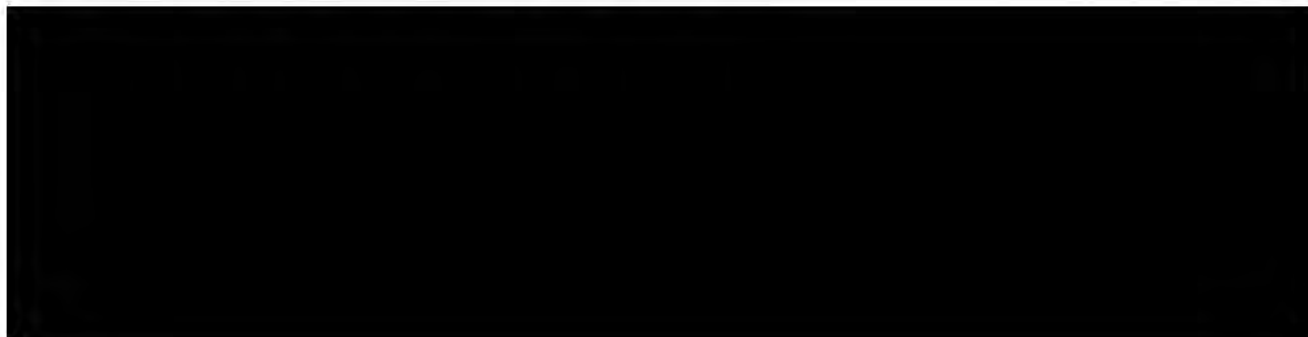

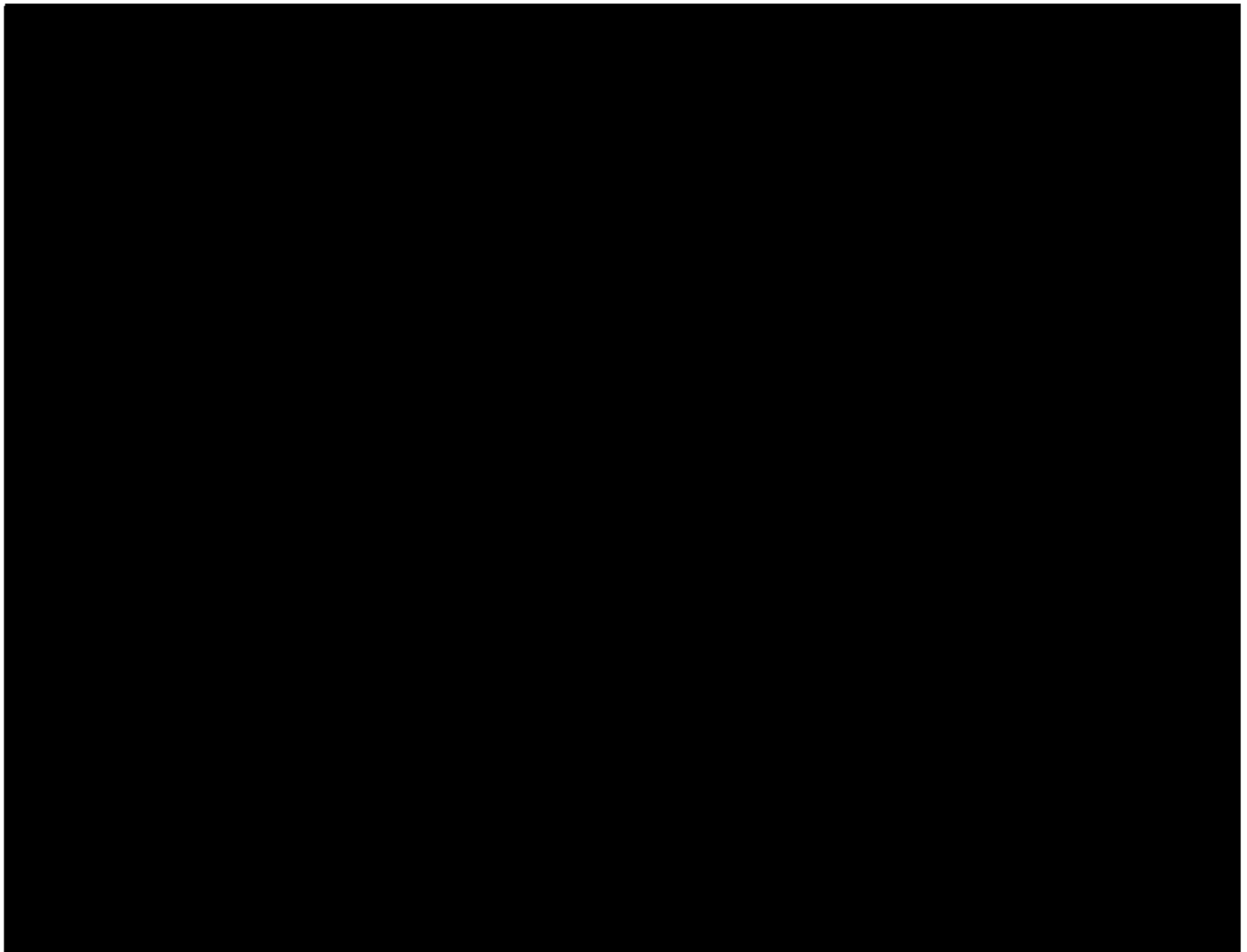
**HISTORY OF DEATH:** The following information is obtained from the deputy coroner investigative report. On December 2, 2015 a shooting incident was reported to the San Bernardino Police Department (SBPD) from the Inland Regional Center (IRC) in San Bernardino. Two suspects entered the building and began shooting at the attendees of a Christmas party hosted for employees of the San Bernardino County Department of Public Health. Following the shooting, the suspects fled in a vehicle.

Multiple attendees were injured. Fourteen victims were pronounced dead at the scene. Wetzel's body was near the Christmas tree.

**Description of Injuries:**

**Gunshot Wound of the Head:**

Entry: The entry wound is located on the bridge of the nose, 5 inches from the top of the head and 1/4 inch left of midline. It consists of a 1/2 inch defect. There is multiple tearing abrasions present with the tears extending towards the right eye. There is no soot or stippling present.

Exit: The exit wound is located on the bridge of the nose, 4-1/2 inches from the top of the head and 1/2 inch right of midline. It consists of a 1/4 inch defect. No soot or stippling is present.

Re-entry: Re-entry is located on the medial aspect of the right eyebrow, 3 1/2 inches from the top of the head and 1-1/2 inches right of midline. It consists of a 1/2 inch defect. No soot or stippling is present.

Re-exit: The re-exit wound is located on the superior aspect of the right eyebrow, 3 inches from the tops of the head and 2-1/2 inches right of midline. It consists of 1/4 inch defect. No soot or stippling is present.



Direction: The direction of the wound path is from front to back, left to right, and upward.

Path: The bullet perforates the left lateral aspect of the nose, exits the right lateral aspect of the nose, re-enters the medial/inferior aspect of the right eyebrow, and re-exits the lateral/superior aspect of the right eyebrow.

Projectile: None

Associated injuries: Local tissue hemorrhage.

#### **Gunshot Wound of the Left Shoulder:**

Entry: The entry wound is located on the lateral aspect of the left shoulder, 10 inches from the top of the head, 2 inches from the top of the left shoulder, and 9 inches left of midline. It consists of a 1/4 inch circular defect. Marginal abrasion is concentric and measures up to 1/4 inch. Surrounding the entrance wound are multiple irregular red shaped abrasions measuring up to 1/4 inch.

Direction: The direction of the wound path is from left to right, back to front, and downward.

Path: The bullet perforates the left shoulder skin and muscle.

Exit: None

Projectile: A deformed metallic bullet fragment was located in the left shoulder muscle, 3 inches from the top of the left shoulder.

Associated Injuries: Local tissue hemorrhage.

#### **Gunshot Wound of the Left Upper Back:**

Entry: The entry is located in the left upper back, 14 inches from the top of the head and 6 inches left of midline. It consists of a 1/4 inch defect. Marginal abrasion is present from 8 to 2 o'clock position and measures up to 1/8 inch. No soot or stippling is present.

Direction: The direction of the wound path is from back to front, left to right, and downward.

Path: The bullet perforates the left upper back skin, lateral 5<sup>th</sup> left rib, left upper lung lobe, left lower lung lobe, posterior surface of the heart (right and left atrium), right side of the diaphragm, right liver lobe, right anterior 6<sup>th</sup> intercostal space, and left chest subcutaneous tissue.

Exit: None

Projectile: A deformed copper jacketed bullet was recovered from the right chest area (subcutaneous). The bullet was located 23 inches from the top of the head and 5 inches right of midline.

Associated injuries: There are projectile defects of the left lateral 5<sup>th</sup> rib, left lung, heart, right liver lobe, and right anterior 6<sup>th</sup> intercostal space. There is 1400 ml of left hemothorax and 100 ml of right hemothorax. There is associated local tissue hemorrhage. Located around the bullet is surrounding ecchymosis and associated small red laceration.

**Gunshot Wound of the Left Hip:**

Entry: The entry wound is located on the left hip, 38 inches from the bottom of the left heel and 6 inches left of midline. It consist of a 7/8 x 1/2 inch circular defect. Surrounding the entry wound are the following abrasions: Located at the 12 o'clock position is a 1-1/2 inch linear abrasion and located inferiorly are two 1/4 inch abrasions and a 3/8 x 1/4 inch abrasion.

Direction: The direction of the wound path is from left to right, front to back, and upward.

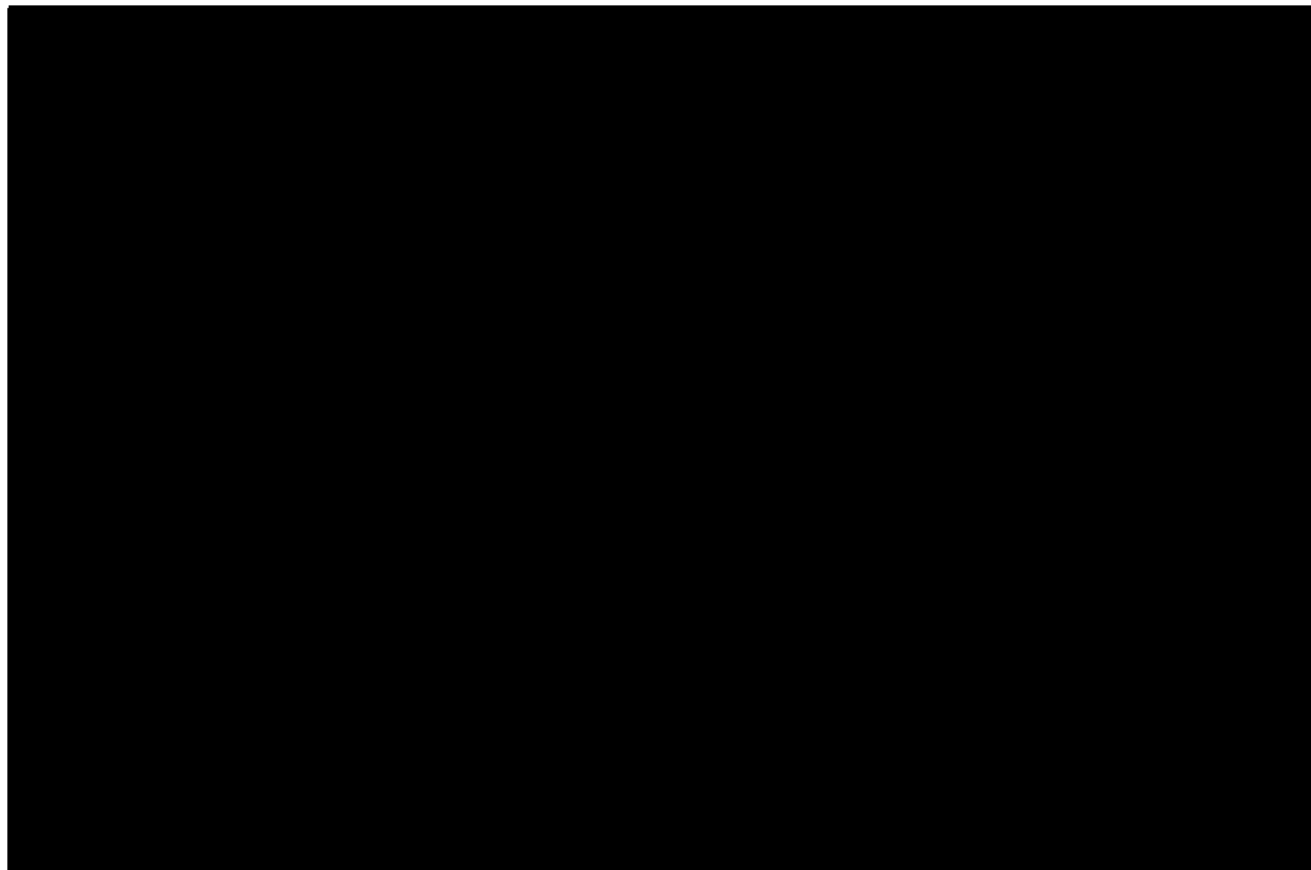
Path: The bullet perforates the left hip skin, left side of the pelvic bone, left inner aspect of the pelvic wall, small bowel, right inner aspect of the pelvic wall, and right buttock muscle/soft tissue.

Exit: None

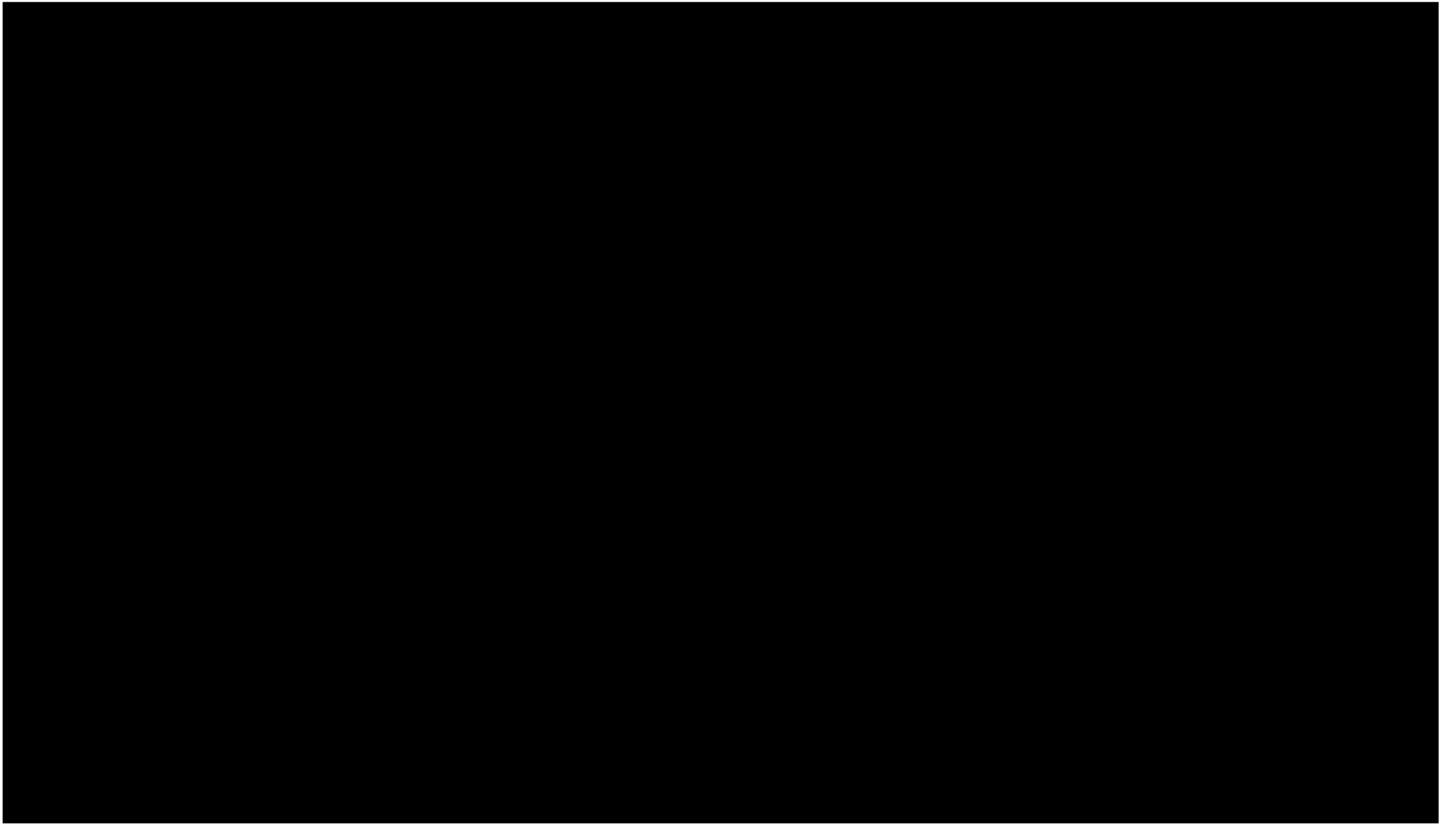
Projectile: A deformed fragment of copper jacketed bullet was recovered from the right buttock area. This bullet fragment was located 33-1/2 inches from the top of the head and 5 inches right of midline.

Associated injuries: The projectile defects of the left side of the pelvic bone, pelvic wall and small bowel. There is local tissue hemorrhage present. There is 100 ml of hemoperitoneum present. Located on the posterior surface of the left thigh are two 1/4 inch red abrasions located 44 and 42 inches from the top of the head.

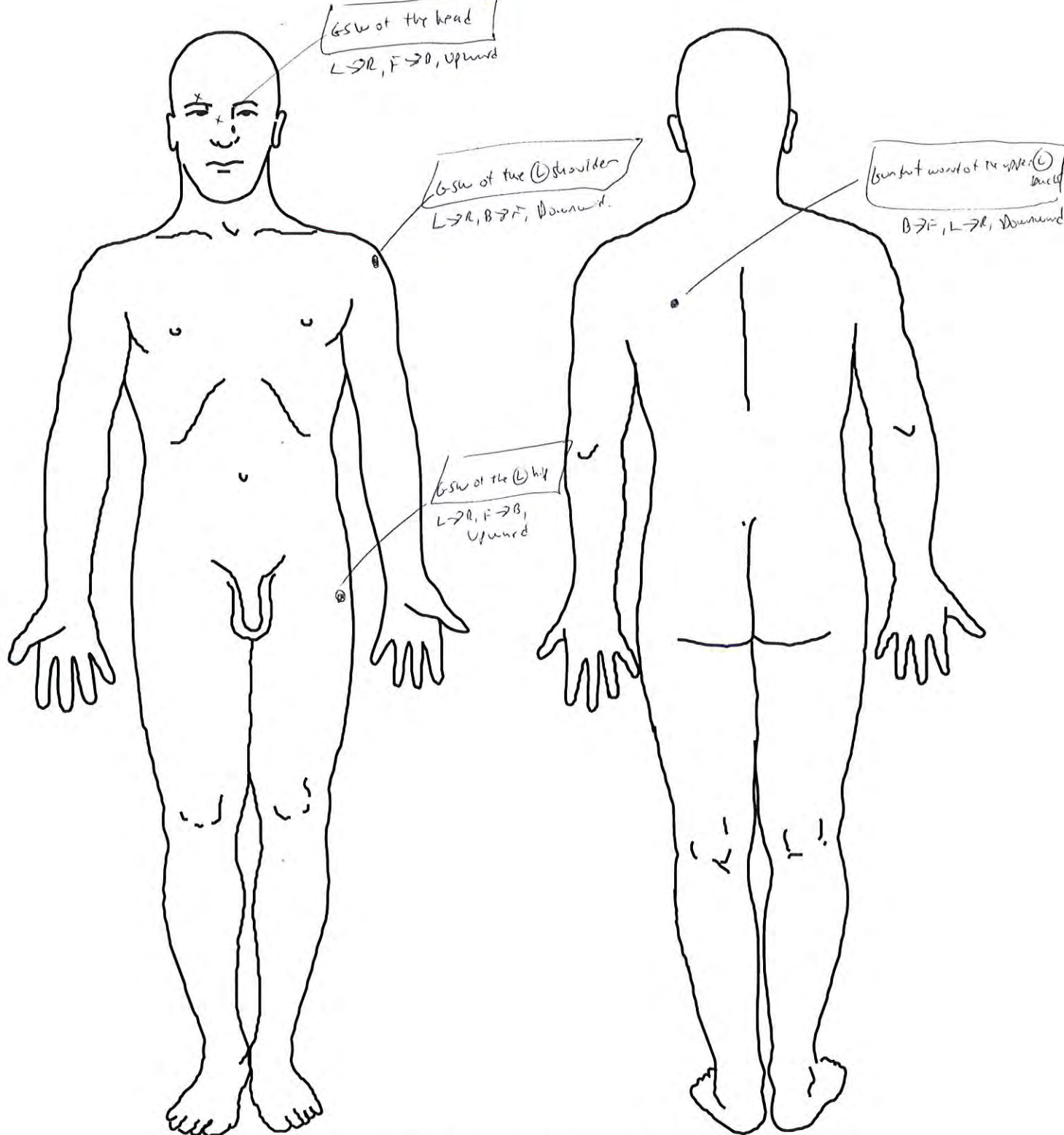
